Verizon 4G wireless antennas in the Tilghman tower have been operational for more than a week. Tilghman residents with 4G Verizon phones are experiencing strong cell phone coverage. Verizon 4G cell phone coverage in Bar Neck and Fairbank varies with some residents reporting no improvement and others experiencing good reception. A couple of days ago I informed Verizon of the poor 4G coverage in Bar Neck and Fairbank. I asked if the antennas had been fully optimized. Verizon called me back this morning to inform me that the antennas were operating at the limits of their capabilities. He indicated that the 4G antennas can handle more volume than older technology but that coverage is more negatively impacted by distance, trees and buildings. He didn't share my surprise and disappointment in the fact that his customers were not getting good coverage 2.5 miles from the tower.
